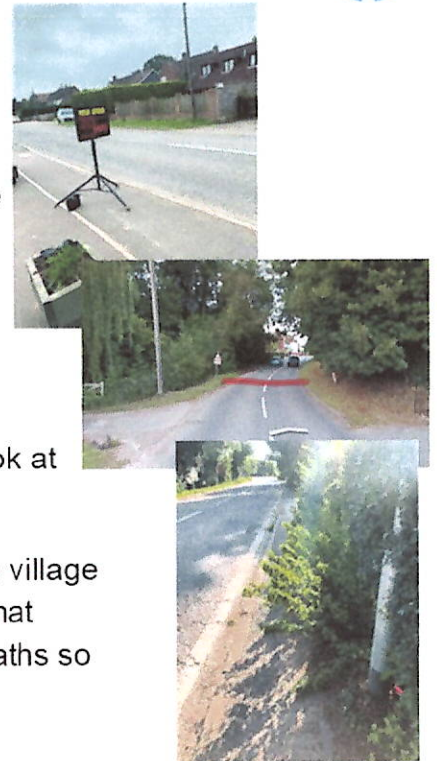
Keeping Villagers Safe ?

We have held our first Speedwatch session in the village and in just an hour 15+ vehicles were noted as coming through the village at 35+ miles an hour in a 30 mile an hour zone.

We are looking for **VOLUNTEERS** to help us with monitoring sessions - if you can help with an hour here and there, please contact Louise our Parish Clerk.

There is currently a **Traffic Survey** being held on Church Hill to look at ways to improve the safety outside the School, Church & Nursery.

Other areas of concern for pedestrians using the paths through the village are the amount of **over grown hedges & verges** - we kindly ask that villagers keep their hedges & verges trimmed well back from the paths so that pedestrians do not need to walk in the road to pass.



Confused about recycling plastics ? Kent Councils have teamed up with national recycling charity **Pledge2Recycle** visit www.pledge2recycle.co.uk/kent to find out what you can recycle, here are a few pointers :-

- 1) All bottles should be clean, empty and with the tops back on.
- 2) All pots, tubs and trays can be recycled as long as they are clean, film lid & an absorbent layer removed.
- 3) You can recycle ALL bottles whether from the bathroom or kitchen as well as food packaging such as pots, trays & tubs as long as they are clean.
